#### **Bus Pass:**

Don't forget to check the date on your bus pass. For the disabled pass you can apply not more than 90 days before it expires or 28 days if you have a concessionary travel pass. For the disabled bus pass it is quite simple, you will be asked if your Personal Independence Payment (PIP) has at least 8 points for 'Moving Around' or Communicating Verbally activities. This is an impossible question to answer unless you have an old copy of the paperwork. Failing this you will have to contact PIP organisation on 08001214433 for a paper copy – this could take a long time on the phone!

You will also need a passport style photograph with your application and evidence of your disability. This could be a copy of your PIP letter.
